Code of Conduct for Students

9. Students are advised to participate actively in the Co-curricular activities conducted by the college from time to time.
10. Students are advised to submit their assignments and internal assessments at the given period.

Code of Conduct for Teachers

The profession of teaching is a talent that demands for high personal standards of ethics, obligation and accountability. A teacher has to lead by example and his / her conduct in an institution as it generates great impact on students.

1. Every Teacher shall discharge his/her duties efficiently and thoroughly to match with the academic standards and performance.
2. Every Teacher shall update his/her knowledge and skills to prepare himself/herself professionally for the proper discharge of duties assigned to him/her.
3. None of the teacher shall associate himself/herself with any political party or take part in any other organizational aggressively, which is not in mark with the obligations and ethics of the teaching profession.
4. No teacher shall by act or deed lower, harass or offence any other person for any reason whatsoever or act in a manner unsuitable for the teaching profession.
5. Every teacher in the service of the College shall strictly follow the orders/rules time to time declared by the UGC, Government of Chhattisgarh, Principal or any other competent authority.

Code of Conduct for the Parents/Guardian

The College ensures an imperturbable learning atmosphere that is helpful, encouraging, empathetic and safe for all the students and staff. Furthermore, the College treats the parents/guardian of every student as an active contributor in building their character and career. Correspondingly, they should unite and keep in touch with the College authorities in such matters.

1. The term “parents/guardians” refers to the person whose name is registered in the admission form at the time of the enrolment of the student.
2. Parents/guardians of the students are expected to maintain the Vision and Mission and Code of Conduct of the College.
3. Parents should make sure that they raise their problems and queries with the right and authorized person at the college campus and should follow the proper communication channel.
4. Parents/guardians should attend the Parents-Teachers’ Meet organized at the intervals and should realize the fact that it is also their collective responsibility.
5. Parents/guardians are advised to meet in person the respective Head of the Departments and Principal regarding the information of their ward in terms of their behaviour, performance and attendance in the college.
6. Parents/guardians should inform and even confirm with the respective Head of the Departments when a student is on leave due to ill health for more than 3 consecutive days.

7. Parents/guardians should maintain a well-mannered and respectful attitude towards the Principal, Staff both teaching and non-teaching of the College.
8. Parents/guardians should ensure that the students maintain attendance as per the University norms.
9. Parents/guardians should make sure that their ward must timely the internal assessment and assignments of every subject given from time to time.
10. Parents/guardians should make a check that there should not be any direct/indirect involvement or encouragement by their ward in leading to ragging or any related violent activity as it may result in the suspension or expelling the student from the college.
